NV Prosecco di Conegliano, Carpena Malvolti

A beautiful and saucily easy-to-drink Prosecco. This sparkling wine from the Veneto in Northern Italy is not too dry and is therefore ideal for drinking on its own i.e. it makes the perfect party wine.

Prosecco is the name of the grape variety used to produce the wine of the DOC (Denominazione di Origine Controllata), the full name of which is Prosecco di Conegliano Valdobbiadene. Producers of the region employ the Charmat method to make their wines fizzy (either frizzante (semi-sparkling), or spumante (fully fizzy)): a secondary fermentation occurs in a pressure tank, rather than in bottle, as with the champagne method.
